**MARKETING OF DAIRY PRODUCTS**

2266. SHRIMATI APARUPA PODDAR:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of proposals to develop dairy and allied services in the country both on individual and cluster capacities;
- (b) the details of financial supports being extended to the entrepreneurs to set up and develop dairy farming along with the extent of central assistances;
- (c) the details of financial support given for dairy farming and product developments since 2017, Statewise; and
- (d) the details of organisations producing and marketing dairy products in the country with export?

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING  
(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)**

(a) &(b) Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying is implementing following schemes / components to provide financial support to entrepreneurs to set up and develop dairy farming: (i) Establishment of Breed Multiplication Farm preferably of indigenous breeds on hub and spoke model is promoted under Rashtriya Gokul Mission. Under the component 50% capital subsidy is available for eligible entrepreneurs (individual/ SHGs/FCO/FPO/JLGs and section 8 companies). Entrepreneurs assisted under establishment of breed multiplication farm are also eligible for interest subvention under Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund. Till date, 49 applications and a sum of Rs. 97.34 crore towards subsidy have been approved by DAHD. State-wise number of proposals and amount of subsidies approved is given at Annexure-I; (ii) Dairy Entrepreneurship Development Scheme (discontinued from March 2020) provided 25% back ended subsidy to general category beneficiaries and 33.33% back ended subsidy to Schedule Caste/ Schedule Tribe category beneficiaries on induction of dairy animals. Details of financial support made available under the scheme is at Annexure-II.

(c) Financial support made available to the States for dairy farming and product development since 2017 State wise and year wise is given at Annexure –III, IV, and V

(d) The details of organisations producing and marketing dairy products in the country is at Annexure-VI. Organisation-wise export details are not available with the Department; however,
