Will the Minister of PLANNING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the NITI Aayog is contemplating to ascertain the skill related requirements and lack of training in the country;
- (b) if so, the details of sectors identified for the purpose;
- (c) whether according to the 68th round of the National Sample Survey more than ten crore workers would enter into the labour market by the year 2023 and will need skill training; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the measures taken by the Government in this regard?

(c) & (d): The NSS 68th Round survey titled “Employment and Unemployment Situation Among Social Groups” of National Sample Survey Office of the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MoSPI) provides estimates pertaining to employment, unemployment situation among the various social groups in the country based on the data collected during the fieldwork of one year duration starting on 1st July, 2011 to 30th June, 2012. The said survey result does not provide any projection relating to labour market and the skill requirement.
