(a): The number of youths selected for training under Rail Kaushal Vikas Yojana across the country is 24,316, out of which 17,069 youths have been trained. The number of applicants from Washim, Yavatmal, Ramtek and Nagpur area of Maharashtra is as under:

(b) & (c): No, Sir. Rail Kaushal Vikas Yojana is a skill development programme for the unemployed youths of India to impart technical training in various trades to enhance their employability and entrepreneurship. Jobs in Railways are through open competitive examinations and, therefore, candidate cannot be given job based on this training. However, this program is to enhance the skill of a person so that he / she can easily get a job or can start his / her own start up. Presently, training is being imparted in 16 technical trades at 94 training centres over Indian Railways spread across the country. The candidates from any part of the country can join this training.
