DIRECT TRAIN CONNECTING DHENKANAL WITH CHENNAI 2398. SHRI MAHESH SAHOO:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that there is no direct train connecting Dhenkanal with Chennai, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to connect Dhenkanal with Chennai either by a train originating from Dhenkanal or by stoppage of any train to Chennai that passes through Dhenkanal;
- (c) if so, the time by which the same will be done; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) At present, there is no direct train connecting Dhenkanal with Chennai. It is operationally not feasible to introduce train service between Dhenkanal and Chennai, at present. However, Chennai bound passengers of Dhenkanal may avail change over at Bhubaneswar, which is approximately 60 km away from Dhenkanal. Besides, introduction/stoppage of train services over Indian Railways is an ongoing process subject to operational feasibility, commercial justification etc.
