OPERATION OF TRAIN SERVICE IN SALEM

2423. SHRI NATARAJAN P.R.:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that all the ordinary passenger trains were running as express special trains from March-2020 in southern railway region particularly in Salem Railway Division with three in fold increase;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefore;
- (c) whether the Government has taken a decision to operate the train service as in the pre covid-19 period with ordinary passenger trains on the representations received from ordinary people and public representatives particularly in Salem Railway Division; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefore?

(a) to (d) Indian Railways, to contain the spread of COVID-19 pandemic, had discontinued all regular passengers carrying trains, including Mail/Express trains, w.e.f 23.03.2020 and only special trains with limited stoppages were being operated. Since, November-2021, train services are being operated with rationalised time table and all Mail/Express trains are being operated with regular numbers whereas passenger services are presently being operated as special services and fare charged as per categorisation.
