- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) the details of the number of backlog vacancies filled by the Central Government;
- (d) the number of current vacancies in the Central Government in Group A, B and C; and
- (e) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to fill the vacancies in Group A, B and C?

(a) to (e): As per the Annual Report of the Department of Expenditure, the number of vacant posts under various Ministries/ Departments of Central Government, as on 01.03.2021, in Group A, B and C is 23584, 118807 and 836936, respectively.

Occurrence and filling up of vacancies is a continuous process. Filling up of vacancies in the Central Government is responsibility of the concerned Ministry/ Department. All Ministries/ Departments of the Central Government are ensuring action in a mission mode for filling up of vacant posts in a time bound manner.
