REDEVELOPMENT OF PLOTS OF NTC

2501. SHRI ARVIND GANPAT SAWANT:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES वस्त्र मंत्री
be pleased to state :

- (a) whether the Government has any plans to redevelop the plots of National Textile Corporation (NTC) in Mumbai and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has any plans to rehabilitate the large number of occupants on such plots of NTC who are in possession of their respective premises since many years;
- (c) if so, the time by which it would be implemented and the place where these people would be rehabilitated;
- (d) whether the Government has planned to rehabilitate these occupants on the plots of NTC in accordance with the policy of Government of Maharashtra and MHADA; and
- (e) if so, the details of the carpet area that would be allotted for the residents and shopkeepers presently residing in these buildings?

(a) to (e): Production activity in NTC working mills were suspended due to Covid-19 pandemic and nationwide lockdown imposed by the various State Governments from March, 2020. Normal operations were resumed in some of the NTC mills from January, 2021 but could not be continued due to unavailability of working capital and other financial constraints. In light of the continued poor economic viability of NTC mills, Ministry of Textiles is preparing an action plan for a way forward in the matter in consultation with NITI Aayog and Department of Public Enterprises, Ministry of Finance.

With regards to redevelopment of plots of NTC in Mumbai and rehabilitation of occupants on such plots of NTC, suitable action is being taken in consultation with Government of Maharashtra under applicable regulations.
