- (a) whether there is an acute shortage of staff in various offices of the Union Government due to non-filling of vacant posts;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) whether the functioning of various Government departments is being adversely affected due to the said shortage and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government is taking any initiative to fill all the vacant posts in the said offices in a time bound manner;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (f): Filling up of vacant posts is a continuous process and Vacancies in various Ministries/ Departments of the Central Government, their attached/ subordinate offices arise due to retirement, promotion, resignation, death etc. All Ministries/ Departments of the Central Government are ensuring action in a mission mode for filling up of vacant posts in a time bound manner.
