#### **PROJECTS UNDER SCM**

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the proposals/projects received from various State Governments under Smart Cities Mission (SCM), project/State/district-wise including West Bengal, Bihar and Haryana;
- (b) the number of proposals out of the said proposals for which approval is sought from the advisory committee, district-wise;
- (c) whether several such decisions were taken by the Board of Directors of the Smart City by ignoring the recommendations of the said advisory committee which were not in public interest and which had to be changed multiple times and led to wastage of time and money and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the mechanism evolved for the monitoring of the expenditure of funds along with the role of elected representatives in SCM?

#### **ANSWER**

## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a) to (d): Government of India launched the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities, including those in West Bengal, Bihar, and Haryana, have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. State/UT/Smart City-wise details of projects is given as Annexure-I.

The implementation of SCM at the City level is done by SPVs created for the purpose. These SPVs are entities registered under The Companies Act, 2013 with 50:50 ownership of Urban Local Bodies and respective States. They plan, implement, operate, and monitor their development projects. As per Mission Guidelines, Smart City Advisory Forums (SCAF) have been established in all Smart cities. These SCAFs, inter alia, consist of Member(s) of Parliament, Member(s) of Legislative Assembly, Mayor, District Collector, local youth, technical experts, and other stakeholders. All 100 Smart Cities have established their SCAFs. As on 3 March 2023, 749 SCAF meetings have been convened by these 100 Smart Cities. SCAFs have the mandate to advise and enable collaboration among various stakeholders in Smart City development. Approval to projects is provided by the Boards of SPVs.

At State level, Mission implementation is coordinated by the State level High Powered Steering Committee (HPSC). At the National level, implementation of SCM is monitored by an Apex Committee headed by Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA). Nominee Directors of MoHUA on the Boards of SPVs monitor progress in respective cities on a regular basis. MoHUA regularly interacts with the States/Smart Cities through video conferences, review meetings, field visits, regional workshops etc. at various levels to assess the performance of cities and handhold them for improving the same. Smart Cities are assessed on various parameters including, but not limited to, project implementation and utilization of funds through the Real Time Online Geospatial Management Information System (GMIS).
