- (d) the details of the timelines, targets and accomplishments thus far made under the scheme?**

(a) : Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) aims at reducing poverty and vulnerability of urban poor households on a sustainable basis. A statement showing State/Union Territory (UT)-wise physical progress of the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) under various components during the last three financial years and the current year (i.e. 2019-20 to 2022-23 {upto 28.02.2023}) is at Annexure-I.

(b):As informed by the State of Andhra Pradesh, the statement showing district-wise physical progress of the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) in the State of Andhra Pradesh under various components during the last three financial years and the current year (i.e. 2019-20 to 2022-23 {upto 28.02.2023}) is at Annexure-II.
