**ASSISTANCE TO STRESSED MSMEs**

2656. SHRI ABHISHEK BANERJEE:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the percentage of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) from each State in the country;
- (b) the number of people employed by MSMEs, State-wise; and
- (c) the steps being taken by the Government to address lack of availability of credit, rising cost of raw materials and base metals and lack of targeted assistance to stressed sectors?

**ANSWER**

(a): As on 13.03.2023, the percentage of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) which are registered on Udyam Registration Portal, from each State/UT is attached as annexure-I.

(b): As per Udyam Registration Portal, the total number of people employed by MSMEs from 01.07.2020 to 12.03.2023 (as on 13.03.2023) in all India was 10,53,66,481. The State/UT wise details are attached as annexure-II.

(c): The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises implements various schemes for the growth and development of MSME sector in the country in areas of credit support, raw material assistance, technological assistance, infrastructure development, skill development and training and market assistance to MSMEs. The schemes/programmes inter alia include Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Credit Guarantee Scheme for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE), Raw Material Assistance (RMA) Scheme of National Small Industries Corporation Limited (NSIC), Micro and Small Enterprises-Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP), Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI), A Scheme for Promoting Innovation, Rural Industry & Entrepreneurship (ASPIRE), Entrepreneurship Skill Development Programme (ESDP) and National SC/ST Hub (NSSH).

The Government has taken a number of recent initiatives to support MSMEs in the country, which inter alia include:

- (i) Rs. 5 lakh crore Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) for business, including MSMEs.
- (ii) Rs. 50,000 crore equity infusion through MSME Self-Reliant India Fund.
- (iii) New revised criteria for classification of MSMEs.
- (iv) No global tenders for procurement up to Rs. 200 crores.
- (v) "Udyam Registration" for MSMEs, for Ease of Doing Business.
- (vi) Launching of an online Portal "Champions" in June, 2020 to cover many aspects of e-governance including grievance redress and handholding of MSMEs.
- (vii) Inclusion of Retail and Wholesale trades as MSMEs w.e.f. 02<sup>nd</sup> July, 2021.
- (viii) Non-tax benefits extended for 3 years in case of an upward change in status of MSMEs.
- (ix) Roll out of Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance (RAMP) programme with an outlay of Rs. 6,000 crore over 5 years.
- (x) Launch of Udyam Assist Platform (UAP) on 11.01.2023 to bring the Informal Micro Enterprises (IMEs) under the formal ambit for availing the benefit under Priority Sector Lending (PSL).
