(b) the details of central funds released/utilized during the last three years, State-wise;

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a) Based on the outcome of techno-economic feasibility and Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) of the 111 National Waterways (NWs), action plan formulated for 26 NWs which have been found viable for cargo/passenger movement/transportation purpose. At present, development initiatives have been taken up in the first 18 NWs out of the 26 viable NWs (rivers), State-wise as detailed at **Annex.-1**.

(b) Central funds allocated and expenditure incurred during last three years on NWs in various States is detailed at **Annex. -2.**

(c) National Waterways are developed to promote environment-friendly, costeffective and location-specific alternate mode of Inland Water Transport (IWT) supplementary to existing Rail and Road transport, wherever feasible. Development of National Waterways is not connected with river linking projects.

(d) Does not arise.
