(a) & (b): Gas hydrate exploration in India is taken up under National Gas Hydrate Program (NGHP). Till date, two expeditions have been undertaken under NGHP to explore the presence of gas hydrates. Under the first programme, NGHP-01 undertaken in 2006, 39 holes were drilled at 21 sites in Krishna-Godavari (KG), Mahanadi, Andaman, and Kerala-Konkan Basin and under the second programme, NGHP-02, in 2015, 42 holes were drilled at 25 sites in KG and Mahanadi Basin.
