TRAUMA CARE TO ACCIDENT VICTIMS

2696. ADV. DEAN KURIAKOSE:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of persons injured and died in road accidents during the last two years and the current year, State-wise;**
- (b) whether the Government proposes to make it mandatory that trauma care be provided for free to all the accident victims in the first 48 hours after the accident; and**
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?**

(a) As per the data received from police department of all States/UTs, the total number of road accidents fatalities and injuries in the country during the year 2019 to 2021 is given in the table below : -

Year	Total Number of Fatalities	Total Number of People Injured
2019	151113	451361
2020	131714	348279
2021	153972	384448

State/UT wise, information on total number of road accidents fatalities and injuries in the country during the year 2019 to 2021 is annexed as per Annexure.

(b) & (c) National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has envisaged a cashless treatment facility on all four arms of Golden Quadrilateral stretch i.e. Delhi-Mumbai, Mumbai-Chennai, Chennai-Kolkata and Kolkata-Delhi to provide Hospitalization Insurance cover to the immediate road Accident Victims (including Drivers, Passengers, Pedestrians/Cyclist). The proposed scheme is to take care of the immediate needs of the hospitalization of the victims for the first 48 hours from the time of hospitalization or providing necessary treatment up to a cost of Rs. 30,000/, whichever occurs earlier.
