- (a) whether the Chennai Port-Maduravoyal Elevated Expressway project is proposed to be revived with the modified plan which was abandoned by NHAI midway due to the cancellation of permission by the Government of Tamil Nadu in 2011-12;**
- (b) if so, the details and the estimated cost thereof;**
- (c) the time by which the work on this project is likely to commence;**
- (d) whether the said project would be taken up under the PM Gati Shakti - NMP to ensure its timely implementation and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor along with the steps taken to ensure expeditious implementation of the project?**
