LPG COVERAGE

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of LPG coverage and share of households using clean fuel in percentage of terms as of July 2022, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the details of the total number of beneficiaries under Pradhan MantriUjjwalaYojana (PMUY), number of said beneficiaries who refilled cylinders once and did not refill cylinders even once respectively for FY 2021-22;
- (c) whether it is a fact that 90 lakh beneficiaries under the Pradhan MantriUjjwalaYojana did not refill their cylinders in FY 2021-22 and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Government has conducted any study on the implementation of PMUY and if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Government is taking any steps to ensure subsidy for subsequent cylinder refills under PMUY reaches beneficiaries on time and if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) whether the Government has assessed the effect of rising LPG prices on LPG usage under PMUY and if so, the details thereof?

- (a) State-wise details of domestic LPG customers of Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) and LPG coverage based on estimated number of households are at **Annexure**.
- (b) & (c)As on 31.03.2021, there were 7.99 crore Pradhan Mantri UjjwalaYojana(PMUY) households in the country. Out of these 7.99 crore beneficiaries, 7.07 crore (89%) beneficiaries have taken at least one refill during 2021-22.
- (d) to (f) LPG consumption of PMUY beneficiaries is monitored on regular basis. Consumption of domestic LPG by households depends on several factors like food habits, household size, cooking habits, price, availability of alternate fuels etc. Per capita consumption of PMUY beneficiaries has increased from 3.01 refills in 2019-20 to 3.68 in 2021-22.

Government has taken several steps to encourage consumption of LPG by PMUY beneficiaries, which include subsidy of Rs. 200/- per 14.2 Kg refill upto 12 refills/year for PMUY beneficiaries for year 2022-23, option of 5 Kg Double Bottle Connection (DBC), swap option from 14.2 Kg to 5 Kg, upto 3 free refills to PMUY beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package from April to December 2020 etc.
