Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of existing natural gas pipeline infrastructure in the country;
- (b) the aims and objectives of National Gas Grid project along with the pipelines identified for the purpose;
- (c) the existing geographical area and population covered under the current City Gas Distribution (CGD) network in the country, State/UT-wise;
- (d) the status of projects currently underway under the National Gas Grid, State/UT-wise;
- (e) whether the Government is running behind schedule to complete these pipeline networks; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof along with the timeline fixed to complete the said network; and
- (g) the other steps taken by the Government to complete natural gas pipeline networks in different districts of Tamil Nadu in time bound manner?

(a) and (b): With the aim to increase the share of natural gas in the Primary Energy mix, to provide access for clean and green fuel throughout the country, connecting gas sources to major demand centres, ensuring availability of gas to City Gas Distribution (CGD), Fertilizer, Power, Petrochemical, Steel, Manufacturing sectors etc., there is focus on developing the Natural Gas infrastructure in the country and to implement "One Nation One Gas Grid". List of fully operational common carrier natural gas pipelinesare at **Annexure-I.**

- (c): After completion of 11-A CGD bidding round, 297 Geographical Areas (GAs) covering about 98% of the population and 88% of total geographical area of the country spread over around 630 districts in 28 States/UTs, have been issued authorization for setting up of CGD network.State/UT-wise details of CGD networks in the country are at **Annexure-II**.
- (d)to(f): State/UT-wise details of projects currently underway under the National Gas Grid are given at **Annexure-III**. The projects are being undertaken as per the timelines approved by Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB).
- (g): After completion of 11-A CGD bidding round, 18GAs covering all districts of Tamil Nadu (including 1 GA spread over neighbouring UT of Pondicherry and 1 over neighbouring states Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka) have been authorized by PNGRB. The development of CGD network are carried out by the CGD entities as per the Minimum Work Programme (MWP) targets provided by the PNGRB and techno-commercial feasibility. As per MWP, authorized entities are to complete the development of CGD network by 2030.
