ROADS BUILT BY NHA! IN ASSAM

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and present status of roads built by National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) in the State of Assam including Silchar Lok Sabha Constituency since 2019;
- (b) the funds utilised thereon during the said period; and
- (c) the present status of construction of the four lane expressway from Nirimbunglow to Jatinga?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) is implementing East – West Corridor project having a length of about 635.997 km in Assam from Srirampur (West Bengal/Assam border) to Silchar via Bongaigaon, Nalbari, Guwahati, Nagaon, Daboka, Maibong, Jatinga. Out of total 635.997 Km length, four-laning of 586.487 km has been completed.

Since 2019, total 23.34 km National Highways (NHs) has been completed in Assam under NHAI.

(b) Details of amount utilized since 2019 on different National Highways development works in the State of Assam by NHAI is as following:

(c) Narimbanglo to Jatinga section is a part of the four laning project from Narimbanglo – Jatinga – Harangajao which has already commenced from 16.01.2023 having a completion period of three years.
