Will the **MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether MBBS students can opt for internship in AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga, Unani, Homoeopathy and Siddha) along with other related postings;
- (b) if so, the details of procedure thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to include super speciality skills in internship training in the hospitals; and
- (d) if so, the State/UT-wise details thereof?

(a) to (d): MBBS Students can opt for any elective from Ayurveda, Yoga, Unani, Siddha, Homeopathy, and Sowa-Rigpa (AYUSH) for one week posting during internship along with other postings. This was notified in the National Medical Commission (Compulsory rotating medical Internship) Regulations, 2021.
