## Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) the number of Trauma centres setup/proposed to be set up for treatment of the patients injured in accidents in the country, State/UT-wise including Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra;
(b) the number of proposals pending with the Union Government for setting up of Trauma Centers in the country particularly in Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra;
(c) the present status of such pending proposals and the time by which these are likely to be approved;
(d) the average distance at which trauma centres are setup for providing treatment to the patients injured in accidents at present; and
(e) the amount of funds being spent every year for providing treatment to the patients injured in accidents in the country, State/UT- wise including Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra?

## ANSWER <br> THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (d) During $11^{\text {th }}$ Five Year Plan (2007-2012) and $12^{\text {th }}$ Five Year Plan (2012-2017) under "National Programme for Prevention and Management of Trauma and Burn Injuries" 196 Trauma Care facilities (TCFs) were sanctioned at an average distance of 100 Km across the country. Approvals were granted on the basis of the proposals received from the States as per the norms of the scheme. There is no provision of the identification of new trauma care facilities under the aforementioned Programme beyond $12^{\text {th }}$ Five Year Plan. Details of sanctioned TCFs are at Annexure -I .
(e) No such data is maintained centrally.
