## **BENEFICIARIES UNDER PMMVY**

## 286. DR. JAYANTA KUMAR ROY: SHRIMATI SANGEETA KUMARI SINGH DEO:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of eligible beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) during the years 2017-18 till date, State-wise;
- (b) the total number of beneficiaries actually benefitted during the said period, Statewise;
- (c) whether there is any role of State Governments in implementation of PMMVY scheme, if so, the details thereof and the steps taken to ensure full co-operation between the Union and the States in this regard;
- (d) whether the number of beneficiaries is low in the State of West Bengal and Odisha for various reasons including lack of co-operation from the concerned State Government; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the corrective steps taken/proposed to be taken in this regard?

#### ANSWER

## MINISTER FOR WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) & (b) The State/UT-wise total number of eligible beneficiaries who have enrolled and total number of beneficiaries provided maternity benefit under the Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) since inception of the scheme in 2017-18 and till 27.01.2023 is at **Annexed**.

(c) The PMMVY is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme being implemented through State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. In order to ensure proper implementation of PMMVY in States/UTs, the Ministry of Women and Child Development handholds all States/UTs on issues related to Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana-Common Application Software (PMMVY-CAS); facilitate scheme implementation by supporting, planning and monitoring activities associated with the technology solution; developing Information Education and Communication (IEC) plan, training modules, capacity building of Accredited Social Health Activist (ASHA), Auxiliary Nurse and Midwife (ANM) and Anganwadi Workers (AWWs).

(d) & (e) The PMMVY is being implemented in the State of West Bengal since 2017-18. However, it had come to the notice of this Ministry that the Scheme is being implemented in the State with a different nomenclature i.e. 'Bangla Matri Prakalpa'. The State government later on agreed that scheme was being run as 'Bangla Matri Prakalpa' and assured that in future the scheme would be implemented strictly as per the guidelines of PMMVY. On receipt of the written assurance from the State, the release of Central share of funds to the State Government of West Bengal has been resumed from March, 2022.
