SHRI BHAGIRATH CHOUDHARY:**

Will the Minister of **AYUSH** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has formulated or implemented any scheme for developing herbal gardens in the country;
- (b) if so, the details of the existing herbal gardens, State/UT-wise including Rajasthan;
- (c) the present status of projects sanctioned for development of herbal gardens in the country including Rajasthan during the last five years;
- (d) the amount of funds allocated and spent for the said projects during the last five years;
- (e) whether the Government proposes to set up new herbal gardens at Ajmer in Rajasthan and in Kerala also to promote AYUSH medicines; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof along with the time frame for setting up of such gardens in the said areas and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b) Yes Sir, presently, the 'National Medicinal Plants Board', Ministry of Ayush is implementing a "Central Sector Scheme on Conservation, Development and Sustainable Management of Medicinal Plants" throughout the country under which there is a provision to provide project based support to various Government and Non-Government organizations to develop different types of Herbal Gardens viz. School Herbal Gardens, Institutional/ Public Herbal Gardens and Herbal Gardens of State and National importance. The State /UT-wise detail of different types of Herbal Gardens supported since 2001-02 to till date is given at **Annexure – I**

(c & d) The status of project sanctioned for development of herbal gardens in the country including state of Rajasthan during last five years and the amount of funds sanctioned, spent / utilized for the said projects is given at **Annexure – II**

(e & f) Under the "Central Sector Scheme on Conservation, Development and Sustainable Management of Medicinal Plants" during financial year 2022-23, a project entitled *Establishment of thematic herbal garden at Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) Campus at Thrissur* has been sanctioned for an amount of Rs 43.20 Lakhs in state of Kerala for a period of 5 years. However, no proposal was received from state of Rajasthan to setup new herbal garden at Ajmer.
