(a) whether Indian missions abroad are functioning with limited human and financial resources;

(b) if so, the details of human resources that are currently working in Indian Missions abroad, country-wise;

(c) the annual financial expenditure of Indian Missions abroad during the last three years, yearwise, country-wise;

(d) whether the Government is considering to strengthen Indian Missions abroad; and

(e) the strategies and plan of action that Government has taken in the past to strengthen Indian Missions abroad?

(a & b) The country-wise details of human resources in Indian Missions/Posts abroad as on 8 March 2023 is at Annexure - I. Vacancies in Indian Missions/Posts abroad are regularly reviewed and officers posted against vacancies. Adequate funds are provided for the smooth functioning of Missions and Posts abroad, within the overall budgetary ceilings received from the Ministry of Finance.
