SUPER SPECIALITY DEPARTMENTS UNDER PMSSY

2914. SHRI Y.S. AVINASH REDDY:

Will the **MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the target of connecting 400 specialty departments in Government medical colleges of the country has been achieved under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), if so, the details thereof, and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether there is any target of increasing the bed capacity in 13 AIIMS across the country and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the details of Specialty/Super-Specialty facilities and additional facilities provided by Government, State-wise and AIIMS-wise?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (c): A target of 400 super-specialty Departments under approved projects for upgradation of Government Medical Colleges has been indicated in the Output Outcome Monitoring Framework (OOMF) for PMSSY for the year 2021-22. In completed projects of Super Speciality Blocks, the number of sanctioned Super-Speciality Department is 386. Under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) 22 AIIMS have been approved with sanctioned bed strength of 18,250. AIIMS wise details are at Annexure-I. The details of status of specialty/super specialty Departments in the six functional AIIMS are at Annexure-II.
