(a) & (b) No proposal for introduction of new Petrochemicals and Engineering Institutions in public sector or under PPP mode is under consideration by the Department of Chemicals and Petrochemicals. However, Central Institute of Petrochemicals Engineering & Technology (CIPET), an autonomous organization under the administrative control of Department of Chemicals & Petrochemicals, Ministry of Chemicals & Fertilizers has already setup 8 Institutes of Petrochemicals Technology (IPT), 3 Schools of Advanced Research in Petrochemicals (SARPs), 31 Centres for Skilling and Technical Support (CSTS) and 4 sub centres across various States in India.
