PORT LAND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

2943. SHRI ARVIND GANPAT SAWANT:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has formed Port Land Development Committee to decide the development of Port land in India and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the committee has submitted its report;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government has planned to redevelop the east coast of Mumbai City; and
- (e) the initiatives being taken by Government to develop the Port of Mumbai Port Trust to generate more revenue?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS
(SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

- (a) No such committee i.e. 'Port Land Development Committee to decide the development of Port land in India' has been formed by the Government. However, a committee was constituted by Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways in 2019 to review the existing 'Policy Guidelines for Land Management, 2015 (PGLM, 2015)'.
- (b)&(c) Does not arise in view of (a) above.
- (d) The proposal for development along the eastern waterfront of Mumbai is submitted to State Government of Maharashtra under Maharashtra Regional and Town Planning Act, 1966.
- (e) 13 projects worth Rs.1255.80 Cr. have been taken up at Mumbai Port Authority.
