- (a) whether funds are allocated at district level under National Health Mission (NHM) and if so, the details thereof along with ratio in which said funds are allocated, district-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has received any complaints regarding irregularities or misappropriation of funds under NHM;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise; and
- (d) the details of the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (d): Under the National Health Mission (NHM), financial and technical support is provided to the States/UTs for strengthening the healthcare systems, based on the proposals received from the States/UTs in their Annual Programme Implementation Plan (PIP) and subject to the Resource Envelope (RE).

Information received relating to financial irregularities in various Central Health Schemes are examined as per government rules and appropriate action is taken.
