Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the funds allocated to Andhra Pradesh under the Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY) since 2019 and expenditure reported by the State Government thereunder;
- (b) the number of institutional deliveries registered in the country under the scheme and the ranking of various States therein, State/UT-wise since 2019, including district-wise details of Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) whether there is a provision of cash aid to women of all BPL/Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes category on having institutional delivery in private and Government hospitals under JSY of National Health Mission;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise especially in the rural areas of Uttar Pradesh along with the amount of cash aid specially for various villages/rural and urban areas in Uttar Pradesh; and
- (e) whether there is any provision for financial aid in case of delivery at home and if so, the details thereof?

- (a) Under National Health Mission (NHM), the funds allocation for the Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY) is done as part of RCH Flexible Pool. Details of approvals and expenditure reported by the State of Andhra Pradesh under Janani Suraksha Yojana since FY 2019-20 are given in the table below:

details of the number of institutional deliveries for the State of Andhra Pradesh under the scheme is given at **ANNEXURE-2**. The State-wise details of total institutional deliveries including Andhra Pradesh as per NFHS-5 (2019-21) is given at **ANNEXURE-3**.

(c) to (e) Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY) implemented under the National Health Mission (NHM) is a safe motherhood intervention promoting institutional delivery among pregnant women especially with weak socio-economic status i.e. women from Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and BPL households.

The details of eligibility and cash aid/ financial assistance under JSY in rural and urban areas for States/UTs including Uttar Pradesh is as follows:

Eligibility and Cash Assistance under JSY:

The eligibility for cash assistance under JSY is as shown as under:

Low Performing States (LPS)*	1400	1000	Available to all women regardless of age and number of children for delivery in government / private accredited health facilities.
High Performing States (HPS)**	700	600	Available only to BPL/SC/ST women regardless of age and number of children for delivery in government / private accredited health facilities.
Financial Assistance for Home Delivery			
Low Performing States (LPS)*	500	500	Available only to BPL women (regardless of age and number of children) who prefer to deliver at home.
High Performing States (HPS)**	500	500	

* Low Performing States (LPS) are the States/UTs which have low institutional delivery rates, namely, Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand.

** High Performing States (HPS) are the remaining States/UTs where the levels of institutional delivery are satisfactory.
