Will the MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to fill the seats of National Board of Examination (NBE) Post-MBBS Diploma courses through the State-level counseling by determining the reservation policy on the lines of PG courses or is contemplating to allow the State Governments to fill the vacant seats of in-service doctors from the fresh candidates after the completion of the second round of counseling; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) & (b): Fifty percent (50%) of NBE Post MBBS Diploma seats in Government Hospitals of a particular State are retained and filled/allocated by the concerned State itself through its own counseling. As per the scheme, the Post MBBS Diploma seats retained by the State Government are allocated only to the in-service doctors of the concerned State.
