SUPER SPECIALITY HOSPITALS/BLOCKS UNDER PMSSY

298. SHRI KRUPAL BALAJI TUMANE: DR. DNV SENTHILKUMAR S.: SHRI ACHYUTANANDA SAMANTA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government have sanctioned/ approved setting up of Super Speciality Blocks/hospitals under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana and if so, the details thereof along with the present status of such blocks/hospitals, State/ UT-wise including Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Odisha and in tribal and backward areas of the country;
- (b) the funds allocated by the Government in this regard;
- (c) whether there is a shortage of specialist doctors in the such Super Speciality Blocks/hospitals and if so, the details thereof and reaction of the Government thereto along with efforts made to meet the requirements;
- (d) whether the Government has also taken steps to establish Super Speciality Hospitals at par with All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Delhi in other State/UTs including Tamil Nadu and if so, the details of the action taken in this regard; and
- (e) the steps taken/proposed to be taken for setting up Medical colleges in tribal districts of the country including in Kandhamal Parliamentary Constituency of Odisha?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (b): Total 75 projects of upgradation of Government Medical Colleges/Institutions (GMCIs) have been approved under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) for setting up of Super Speciality Block (SSB)/Trauma Centre. The status of these projects

State/UT-wise, including Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Odisha and in tribal and backward areas along with approved cost of projects is at **Annexure I.**

(c): As per the PMSSY, operation and maintenance of the facilities created under the Scheme including the creation of post and the recruitment of human resources is the responsibility of the State Government.

(d): Under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana, Union Cabinet has approved setting up of 22 All India Institutes of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) including one AIIMS at Madurai in Tamil Nadu. These AIIMS are listed below;

(e): This Ministry is also implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme for 'Establishment of new Medical Colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals', with preference to underserved areas and aspirational districts, where there is no existing Government or private medical college.
