WORKING WOMEN HOSTELS

300. MS. NUSSRAT JAHAN:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of working women hostels being operated by the Government in Basirhat district of West Bengal;
- (b) the details of all such facilities available in the said state, city-wise;
- (c) the manner in which the Government plans to expand such facilities;
- (d) the details of women enrolled and getting benefitted from such facilities during the last five years; and
- (e) the total expenditure incurred by the Government on the said facilities/scheme?

ANSWER

- (a) & (b) As informed by the State Government of West Bengal, it does not implement any scheme on Working Women Hostel (WWH) in the State.
- (c) to (e) Under the newly approved Mission Shakti, the WWH known as Sakhi Niwas. This is a demand driven scheme, meant to promote availability of safe and conveniently located accommodation for working women, with day care facility for their children, in urban, semi-urban, or even rural areas where employment opportunity for women exist, as per local needs and requirement of the States/UTs.

During the last five years period expenditure for an amount of Rs.121.40 crores has been incurred under the Scheme i.e. Financial Years 2017-18 to 2021-22 with 23319 women beneficiaries.
