- (a) the total number of Institutes of National Importance (INIs) in India as on date, institute-wise;
- (b) the number of INIs where the post of Chairperson and other posts in the governing body are lying vacant as on date, institute-wise;
- (c) the date on which vacancy arose in the post of Chairperson and other posts in the governing body, institute-wise;
- (d) whether the Government has set any deadline to fill these vacant posts; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

# MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a) to (e): Institutions of National Importance (INIs) are created/designated through an Act of Parliament. There are 161 INIs in India under different ministries/departments, enlisted at <u>https://www.education.gov.in/institutions-national-importance</u>. Each INI is governed by its respective Act. The filling up of the posts of governing body of each INI is a continuous process and is done as per the provisions of their respective Act.
