**FUNDS TO PMKVY 4.0**

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the features of the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana;
- (b) the details of the funds sanctioned, allocated and utilized under this yojana during the last three years and the current year including Assam and Rajasthan;
- (c) the details of the target set and achievements made so far along with its response within the country;
- (d) the details of the funds likely to be sanctioned under 4.0;
- (e) the details of the target likely to set under this yojana; and
- (f) the time by which it is likely to be launched?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

(a) Under Skill India Mission, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship is delivering skills through its flagship Scheme, Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana since 2015 in three phases. Some of the salient features of the PMKVY are as follows:

- i. Demand driven with bottom-up approach has been adopted.
- ii. District Skill Committees (DSCs) are the focal point for implementation of the Scheme at the district level. The DSCs are entrusted with district level skill gap and demand assessment, mobilization and counselling of candidates, formation of training batches, post training support and provide handholding support to the candidates after placements, besides addressing the grievances, if any.
- iii. The scheme is aligned with Common Cost Norms and National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF).
- iv. Payment to Training Providers has been provided into three (3) tranches. Other incentives like boarding & lodging, post-placement support, conveyance and other support are as per Common Cost Norms.

- v. Private sector participation is encouraged with greater focus on training in industries.
- vi. Cross utilisation of available infrastructure with ITIs/School/Universities.
- vii. Phase-wise introduction of vocational courses in schools in coordination with Ministry of Education.

(b) State-wise details of funds sanctioned, disbursed and utilized under Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM)/ State component of PMKVY 2.0 & 3.0 during last three years and current financial year including State of Assam and Rajasthan is given at **Annexure-I (Part A)** and **Annexure-I (Part B)**, respectively and details of state-wise funds released under CSCM / Central Component of PMKVY 2.0 & 3.0 during last three years is given at **Annexure-II**

(c) Since inception, i.e. 2015, till 31.12.2022, 1.37 Crore candidates trained/oriented in PMKVY 1.0, 2.0 and 3.0.

(d) to (f) Based on the learnings from implementation of earlier phases of Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Ministry has conceived the new version of PMKVY, i.e., PMKVY 4.0. PMKVY 4.0 has been appraised and recommended by Expenditure Finance Committee (EFC) and it has also been announced in Budget 2023. The Ministry has started the preparatory work to implement the PMKVY 4.0
