YOUTH TRAINED UNDER PMKVY/SANKALP

3061. DR. MOHAMMAD JAWED:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the Skill Development Centre set up in Bihar particularly in districts Kishanganj and Purnia since its inception of the scheme in 2016;
- (b) the details and the number of youth trained under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana, Skill Acquisition and Knowledge Awareness for Livelihood Promotion, Standard Training Assessment and Reward and Udaan from centres in Bihar particularly in districts Kishanganj and Purnia;
- (c) the details of the number of youth who get job opportunities or have been able to start their own small time unit; and
- (d) the details of the amount sanctioned and spent in view of the above?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

(a) Under Skill India Mission, Ministry is implementing various programmes/ schemes for the skill development of youth across the country including in the State of Bihar such as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) and Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs). MSDE also promotes establishment of model training centres across the country known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) under PMKVY. The district-wise number of skill development centres that have imparted training in the State of Bihar particularly in districts of Kishanganj and Purnia under the various programmes of MSDE, is given at Table I of **Annexure**.

(b) The district-wise candidates trained/enrolled under various programmes/ scheme of MSDE such as PMKVY, JSS and Skill Acquisition and Knowledge Awareness for Livelihood Promotion (SANKALP) in the State of Bihar is given at Table II of **Annexure**.

'Udaan' was a Special Industry Initiative by Ministry of Home Affairs for the Youth of Jammu & Kashmir. Also, National Skill Certification and Monetary Reward Scheme known as STAR Scheme was implemented by Ministry of Finance and around 14 lakh candidates were trained across the country including State of Bihar.

(c) Under the Short term training (STT) component of PMKVY, successfully certified candidates are facilitated with placement opportunities, while Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is not linked with placements as it recognizes the existing skills of candidates. Under placement linked component of PMKVY, 24.36 lakh candidates have been reported placed including 2.94 lakh self employed candidates in various sectors across the country. In the State of Bihar, 1,15,401 and 9,409 candidates have been reported placed and self employed, respectively.

(d) Under PMKVY 2.0 and 3.0, Rs.128.66 Crore and Rs. 15.77 Crore have been allocated to State of Bihar out of which Rs. 36.82 Crore have been released and Rs. 15.77 Crore have been utilized by the State. Under SANKALP, Rs. 26.07 Crore has been released to State of Bihar.
