DECLARATION OF ASI MONUMENTS AS MONUMENTS OF NATIONAL IMPORTANCE

3076. SHRI RAJENDRA AGRAWAL:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of monuments, sites declared by the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) as monuments of national importance, State-wise including Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) the details of funds spent on the said monuments and sites during the last two years;
- (c) the revenue earned by Government from these monuments during each of the last two years, State-wise details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government is considering to declare other monuments of Uttar Pradesh as monuments of national importance and if so, the details of the identified monuments and the time by which these are likely to be declared as monuments of national importance?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF CULTURE, TOURISM AND DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION (SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

- (a) There are 3696 centrally protected monuments/sites in the country, which include 743 monuments/sites in the State of Uttar Pradesh. Details are given at **Annexure.**
- (b) Details of the amount spent on conservation, preservation and maintenance of these monuments and sites during the last two years are given as under:
