IDENTIFICATION OF VILLAGES FOR CULTURAL MAPPING

3104. MS. DEBASREE CHAUDHURI:
SHRI CHANDRA SEKHAR BELLANA:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has undertaken a National Mission on Cultural Mapping (NMCM) of the country;
- (b) whether it is a fact that 75 villages have been identified for this purpose on pilot basis;
- (c) if so, the details of villages identified, State-wise, with particular reference to West Bengal and Andhra Pradesh and how this will help the artists and communities of these areas;
- (d) the details of database that Government is planning to build under the above mission;
- (e) the details of schemes and programmes of the Government going to be extended to artists in that areas; and
- (f) the efforts being made by the Government to link tourism with culture in the above village so as to achieve twin objectives of protecting culture and developing that area as tourist hub?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF CULTURE, TOURISM AND DEVELOPMENT

- (a) Yes, Sir. Government of India has initiated the National Mission on Cultural Mapping (NMCM).
- (b) 80 villages were initially identified for the pilot study.
- (c) The State-wise details of villages including the villages from the State of West Bengal and Andhra Pradesh is Annexed.
- (d) The proposed database under NMCM includes following constituents:
 - i. National register and interactive database of artists and art practices from the villages of India.
 - ii. National directories of artists and art practices.
 - iii. Unique identification code for the artists.

- iv. E-commerce platform.
 - v. Single cultural service provider platform for all the welfare schemes of Government of India for artists and artisans of the country.
 - vi. Virtual museum of villages showing their arts, crafts and culture.
- (e) & (f) The formation of schemes and programmes is a continuous process. The data base helps the Government in providing benefits to the actual beneficiaries, protection of cultural heritage, development of area and promotion of tourism.
