- (a) the amount of funds released under the 'State Incentive Grants', including details for the State of Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) the number of beneficiaries in the State of Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) the number of beneficiaries reached through the Gender Action Plan (GAP), in the State of Andhra Pradesh; and
- (d) the number of pilot projects implemented through the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), in the State of Andhra Pradesh?

(a) An amount of Rs. 273.99 crore has been released to 31 States/ UTs as Central share, under the 'State Incentive Grants' of Skill Acquisition and Knowledge Awareness for Livelihood Promotion (SANKALP) scheme. This includes Rs. 7.76 crore released to Andhra Pradesh.

(b) & (c) Gender Action Plan (GAP) is aimed at increasing participation of women in the skilling programmes. The total number of candidates and female candidates who received training under schemes of MSDE in the last three years (2019-20 to 2021-22) in the state of Andhra Pradesh is as under:
