TOURIST DESTINATIONS SELECTED THROUGH CHALLENGE MODE IN KERALA

3159. ADV. A.M. ARIFF:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the list of tourism projects being implemented with central assistance in the State of Kerala including those in Alappuzha and Kollam districts:
- (b) whether the Government has finalized the list of fifty tourism destinations to be developed through challenge mode as announced in the Union Budget for 2023-24 and if so, the details thereof including the State and UT-wise sites;
- (c) whether the Government intends to include Pathiramanal Eco Tourism project in the list of fifty tourism destinations to be developed through challenge mode;
- (d) whether the Government will consider providing financial assistance to State of Kerala for developing Alappuzha Marina cum Port project which aims to enhance the tourism prospects of Alappuzha district; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reason therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a): Development and promotion of tourist places is primarily the responsibility of the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. However, the Ministry of Tourism has provided financial assistance under the 'Swadesh Darshan', 'National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)' and 'Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development' Schemes for the development of tourism related infrastructure in the State of Kerala.

The details of the projects sanctioned under the above mentioned schemes in the State of Kerala is given at Annexure. However, the Ministry of Tourism has not sanctioned any project under the above mentioned schemes in Alappuzha and Kollam Districts of Kerala.

- (b) & (c): Ministry of Tourism organized Post Budget Webinar on 3rd March, 2023 on 'Developing Tourism in Mission Mode' with the objective to seek fruitful inputs of stakeholder for implementation of budget announcements. In addition, the Ministry of Tourism has initiated process to work out the modalities in this context.
- (d) & (e): Proposals are received from State Governments/Union Territory Administrations from time to time for seeking financial assistance under the above schemes of the Ministry of Tourism. These proposals are examined in context of the scheme guidelines and financial assistance is extended for projects subject to fulfilment of the stipulated provisions and availability of funds.
