Appointment of Vice-Chancellor

†3195. DR. S. T. HASAN:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the minimum conditions laid down for the appointment of Vice-Chancellor in Universities;
- (b) the minimum experience required for the appointment of a Professor;
- (c) whether the Vice-Chancellor of Allahabad University had fulfilled this condition of minimum experience before his appointment; and
- (d) if not, the basis on which he was appointed?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

(DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

- (a) As per the University Grants Commission (UGC) Regulation 2018, the person to be appointed as Vice-Chancellor of a University should be a distinguished academician, with a minimum of ten years of experience as Professor in a University system or ten years of experience in a reputed research and/or an academic administrative organization with proof of having demonstrated academic leadership.
- (b) As per the UGC Regulation 2018, the person to be appointed as a Professor should hold a minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National level institutions/industries with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.
- (c) and (d) The present Vice-Chancellor of Allahabad University has fulfilled the prescribed eligibility criteria for the post.
