#### VACANT TEACHING POSTS OF RESERVED CATEGORIES IN CEIS

#### 3196. SHRI DHARMENDRA KASHYAP:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken cognizance of the tendency in Central Educational Institutions to keep many reserved teaching posts vacant after conducting recruitment process by declaring none found suitable;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the number of reserved category posts lying vacant in Central Universities, rank/institution-wise;
- (c) the number of such posts for which recruitment process was conducted and none were declared/found suitable, rank/institution-wise; and
- (d) the steps taken or likely to be taken by the Government in this regard?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a) to (d) Central Educational Institutions (CEIs) under Ministry of Education are statutory autonomous organizations established under respective Central Acts of Parliament and governed by provisions of the Acts/Statutes/Ordinances/Regulations made there under. Their recruitment procedure is formulated by their statutory bodies in accordance with their Acts, Statutes and Rules. Reservation in CEIs is provided for all posts in direct recruitment in Teacher's cadre as per the Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Teachers' Cadre) Act, 2019. After enactment of this Act, no reserved post is to be de-reserved. Ministry of Education has given directives to all the CEIs to fill up the vacancies in a Mission Mode within a period of one year starting from 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2021. The Ministry also continuously monitors it with the Institutions, however, the onus of filling up the posts lies on CEIs which are autonomous bodies created under Acts of Parliament. As per records available, recruitment for 1471 faculty posts has been done in Central Universities from 05.09.2021 to 28.02.2023. The details of number of reserved category teaching posts lying vacant in Central Universities, and such posts for which no candidates were declared/found suitable, rank/institution-wise are available at https://www.education.gov.in/parl\_ques.
