**National Afforestation Programme**

3204. SHRIMATI JYOTSNA CHARANDAS MAHANT:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether National Afforestation Programme (NAP) and Green India Mission (GIM) are being run by the Union Government for soil conservation and better land productivity;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the date of their implementation, State-wise;
- (c) whether tree plantation has been done according to its target set under the said programme;
- (d) the number of trees planted under the programme in the agriculture-based State, Chhattisgarh; and
- (e) whether any funds are allocated to the State Government for the operation of the above programme, if so, the details thereof, State and year-wise including Chhattisgarh?

**ANSWER**

- (a) to (c) National Afforestation Programme (NAP) has been the flagship afforestation scheme of the Ministry, implemented since year 2000 on pan India basis, for afforestation in identified degraded forest areas with people's participation and decentralized forest governance. National Mission for a Green India (GIM) aims at protecting, restoring and enhancing India's forest cover through plantation activities in forest and non-forest areas and the activities were started in 2015-16. In order to achieve the targeted objectives of National Afforestation Programme, the Ministry has merged NAP into Green India Mission (GIM) so that the overall greening efforts are augmented. The State wise area taken up under NAP and GIM since 2015-16 is given in **Annexure-1**.
- (d) As per Twenty Point Programme achievements reported under Item No 51(b)-number of seedlings planted on public and forest land- in the State of Chhattisgarh since 2015-16 till 2021-22 is around 3047 lakhs which include the collective achievements done by the State under State Govt. plan and non-plan, Central Govt. Schemes including GIM & NAP and plantation efforts by NGO's, Private organisations, Civil Societies etc.
- (e) The State and year wise funds released under NAP and GIM since 2015-16 till 2021-22 is given in **Annexure-2**.
