**STUDY IN RISE IN SCHOOL DROPOUT RATES**

3215. SHRI SYED IMTIAZ JALEEL:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has conducted any study with regard to rise in school dropout rates especially in case of female students;
- (b) if so, the details of dropout at Primary and Secondary levels during the last two years, State-wise;
- (c) the details of dropout rates in Maharashtra in 2020-21 and 2021-22, district-wise;
- (d) the percentage of attendance of students for 2020-21 and 2021-22; and
- (e) the number of girls of Minority community who have discontinued education in 2020-21 and 2021-22, State-wise especially in Maharashtra?

**ANSWER**

(SMT. ANNPURNA DEVI)

(a) to (e): Unified District Information System for Education Plus (UDISE+) under the Ministry of Education, collects the details about schools and its resources. UDISE+ has a mandate of collecting information from schools imparting formal education from Pre-primary to XII. As per UDISE+, the State-wise Annual Average dropout rate for the year 2020-21 and 2021-22 at primary and Secondary level is at **Annexure-I**.

As per UDISE+ the district-wise Annual Average dropout rate for the year 2020-21 and 2021-22 in the State of Maharashtra is at **Annexure II**.

No data for percentage of attendance of students is maintained centrally.

As per UDISE+ the state-wise Annual Average dropout rate of Minority Girls for the year 2020-21 and 2021-22 is at **Annexure-III**.
