- (a) the salient features of the Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF);
- (b) the quantum of funds utilised under the FIDF and the details of infrastructure created by utilisation of said funds, State wise; and
- (c) the details of projects approved for the State of Andhra Pradesh under FIDF and the time frame by which these would be completed, district-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

(SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

(a) to (c): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying with effect from the financial year 2018-19 has been implementing Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF) with a total fund size of Rs 7522.48 crore. FIDF *inter-alia* provides concessional finance to various Eligible Entities (EEs), including State Governments/Union Territories and State entities for development of identified fisheries infrastructure facilities through the interest subvention up-to 3% per annum with rate of interest not lower than 5% per annum by the Nodal Loaning Entities (NLEs). The maximum repayment is 12 years inclusive of moratorium of 2 years on repayment of principal.

The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying has so far accorded approvals to a total of 121 proposals of various End Implementing Agencies including State Governments/UTs at a total outlay of Rs. 5588.63 crore for development of fisheries infrastructures. The State-wise details of the project approved are furnished below:
