PROJECTS SANCTIONED UNDER PMKSY

Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) the salient features of the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY);
- (b) the details of various schemes/projects being implemented thereunder;
- (c) the details of the funds sanctioned, allocated and utilized under the said yojana during the last three years and the current year in the States of Assam, Maharashtra and Chhattisgarh along with the status of the target fixed for investment under the said yojana;
- (d) the number of sanctioned/approved projects under the said yojana so far along with the details of current status thereof;
- (e) the quantum of funds allocated and spent during the said period; and
- (f) the time by which these projects are likely to be completed?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

- (a) & (b):- Government of India had approved an Umbrella Central Sector Scheme Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samapada Yojana(PMKSY) in May, 2017 with an allocation of Rs. 6,000 Crores for the period 2016-20 co terminus with the 14th Finance Commission Cycle to be implemented by Ministry of Food Processing Industries. The implementation period was later extended to Year 2020-21. Government has further decided to restructure the component schemes for implementation during 15th Finance Commission with total outlay of Rs 4600 Crore, wherein provision for only committed liabilities of component schemes Mega Food Park, Creation of Backward & Forward Linkages, Human Resource & Institution Skill Development has been made and no new projects are to be sanctioned under these components during the period. Promotion Activities & HACCP- a component of Food Safety and Quality Assurance Infrastructure have been discontinued. The component schemes continued during 15th FC Cycle for new projects are
- (i) Integrated Cold Chain and Value Addition Infrastructure (ICC)
- (ii) Creation /Expansion of Food Processing & Preservation Capacities (CEFPPC)
- (iii) Infrastructure for Agro-Processing Clusters(APC)
- (iv) Food Safety and Quality Assurance Infrastructure(FTL)
- (v) Human Resource and Institutions R&D
- (vi) Operation Greens

Under component schemes of PMKSY, MoFPI provides mostly credit linked financial assistance (capital subsidy) in the form of grants-in-aid for setting up of food processing industries/units/projects to eligible applicants selected through Expression of Interest issued from time to time on SAMPADA Portal. Selection of proposals for assistance under these schemes is done as per the respective scheme guidelines through dedicated portal and transparent appraisal process as per the prefixed criteria. Assistance available under schemes administered by MoFPI is placed at **Annexure-I.**

(c) to (f):- PMKSY is a central sector scheme and not specific to any region or state. It is a demand driven scheme and is implemented across the country including Assam, Chhattisgarh and Maharashtra and therefore, state-wise budget allocation is not made under the scheme. However, the details of grants-in-aid sanctioned and released to the projects approved during 2019-20 to 2022-23 in States of Assam, Maharashtra and Chhattisgarh is mentioned at Annexure-II. The details of funds allocated and utilized under PMKSY during 2019-20 to 2022-23 is mentioned in Annexure-III. The details of number of sanctioned/approved projects under PMKSY till date is mentioned in Annexure-IV. The time line for completion of projects are placed at Annexure-V.

The Assistance available under component schemes of PMKSY

Grants-in-aid @ 35 % of eligible project cost, subject to maximum prescribed limit, is provided for general areas for setting up of Food Processing Industries under component schemes of PMKSY, as per current scheme guidelines. Special incentive is admissible for projects approved for SC/ST entrepreneurs / North eastern Region and other difficult and hilly areas.
