PPP MODEL IN COLD CHAIN STORAGE FACILITIES

Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Government has created cold chain storage facilities for vegetables, fruits, food grains under (PPP) model particularly in the State of West Bengal during the last three years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not; the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b): No project under the scheme for "Integrated Cold chain & Value Addition Infrastructure" has been sanctioned by the Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) under Public Private Partnership (PPP) model.

However, during last three years, five projects have been approved by MoFPI under its scheme of Integrated Cold Chain & Value Addition Infrastructure, which are located in the State of West Bengal. The details of these five projects are as under:
