(a) & (b) The details of funds released under Central Finance Commission Grants (FFC) and under the Scheme of Ministry of Panchayati Raj, i.e. Rastriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA), Incentivization of Panchayats (IoP) to the State of Karnataka during the last five years are as follows:

The projects which have been planned by utilizing Central Finance Commission Grants and by way of convergence of other schemes and activities of various Central Government and State Government include improving basic services including supply of drinking water, rain water harvesting, water recycling, sanitation & maintenance of ODF status including management and treatment of household waste, human excreta and faecal sludge management etc. Under the Scheme of Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA) capacity building of the elected representatives and their functionaries of the Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) and infrastructure support like Gram Panchayat Bhawan and computerization of Panchayats like projects are undertaken. The financial incentives received under the scheme of Incentivization of Panchayats(IoP) are also utilised for various developmental projects in the Country including in the State of Karnataka.
