CASES OF CYBER CRIMES AGAINST WOMEN

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is aware that according to National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) statistics, 10,405 cases of cyber crimes against women were reported during 2020;

(b) if so, the details of court trials relating to cyber blackmailing, cyber stalking, online bullying and fake profiling, completed and pending during the last three years, State-wise;

(c) whether the Government has taken any steps to curtail the nationwide rise in cyber crimes against women and if so, the details thereof; and

(d) the corrective measures taken by the Government to ensure effective dispensation of justice?

(a) : Yes Sir.

(b) to (d) : The National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) compiles and publishes the statistical data on crimes in its publication "Crime in India". The latest published report is for the year 2021. As per the data published by the NCRB, State/UT wise and Crime Head-wise details of court trials under cyber crimes against women (involving communication devices as

medium/target) during the period from 2019 to 2021 are at the Annexure-I & II respectively.

‘Police’ and ‘Public Order’ are State subjects as per the Seventh Schedule of the Constitution of India. States/UTs are primarily responsible for the prevention, detection, investigation and prosecution of crimes including cyber crime against women through their Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs).

The Central Government has taken various measures to supplement the efforts of States/UTs to deal with cyber crimes against women which, inter-alia include the following:

- i. The Ministry of Home Affairs has set up the ‘Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C)’ to provide ecosystem for tackling all types of cyber crime in the country, in a coordinated and comprehensive manner.**
- ii. The Ministry of Home Affairs has provided financial assistance under the ‘Cyber Crime Prevention against Women and Children (CCPWC)’ Scheme, to the States/UTs for their capacity building such as setting up of cyber forensic-cum-training laboratories, hiring of junior cyber consultants and training of LEAs personnel, public prosecutors and judicial officers. So far, cyber forensic-cum-training laboratories have been commissioned in 33 States/UTs.**

- iii. **Training curriculum has been prepared for Law Enforcement Agencies personnel, prosecutors and judicial officers for better handling of investigation and prosecution. States/UTs have been mandated to organize training programmes. So far, more than 20,300 LEA personnel, judicial officers and prosecutors have been provided training on cyber crime awareness, investigation, forensics etc.**
- iv. **Directorate of Forensic Science Services (DFSS) has been assigned to set up National Cyber Forensic Laboratory (NCFL) at Hyderabad for evidentiary purpose. NCFL is made operational. Establishment of this laboratory provides the necessary forensic support in cases of evidence related to cyber crime, preserving the evidence and its analysis in line with the provisions of IT Act and Evidence Act; and reduced turnaround time. This laboratory functions as a Model Laboratory for other Central and State Forensic Science Laboratories in the country.**
- v. **Ministry of Home Affairs operationalized the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal www.cybercrime.gov.in to provide a centralized mechanism to the citizens for online reporting of all types of cyber crime incidents, with a special focus on cyber crimes against women and children. Incidents reported on this portal are automatically routed to the State/UT law enforcement agency concerned for taking further steps as per the provisions of the law. A toll-free helpline number '1930' has been operationalized to get assistance in lodging online cyber complaints.**

- vi. **The Massive Open Online Courses (MOOC) platform under the I4C called ‘CyTrain’ portal has been developed. CyTrain portal helps in the capacity building of Police Officers/Judicial Officers through online course on critical aspects of cyber crime investigation, forensics, prosecution etc. along with certification. So far, more than 31,000 Police Officers from States/UTs are registered and more than 8,300 Certificates issued through the portal.**
- vii. **To spread awareness on cyber crime, several steps have been taken that include issuance of alerts/advisories, dissemination of messages through SMS, I4C social media account i.e. Twitter handle(@Cyberdost),Facebook(CyberDostI4C),Instagram(cyberdosti4c),Telegram (cyberdosti4c), Radio campaign, engaged MyGov for publicity in multiple media, publishing of Handbook for Adolescents/ Students, organizing of Cyber Safety and Security Awareness week, in association with police department in different States/UTs etc.**
