NON-PAYMENT TO MATES/SUPERVISORS UNDER MGNREGS

3387. SHRI SUNIL KUMAR SINGH:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds allocated, released and utilized under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) to each State and Union Territory during each of the last three years and the current year, State and districtwise including Jharkhand particularly Chatra, Latehar and Palamu districts;
- (b) whether there have been cases of nonpayment to mates/supervisors under MGNREGS in Rajasthan;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, district-wise and the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the steps being taken to ensure time payment to mates/supervisors?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT
(SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a): Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) is a demand driven wage employment Scheme. There is no State/UT wise allocation of funds under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS. Funds are not released to districts directly under the Scheme.

State/UT wise release of funds under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS during last three financial years and current financial year 2022-23 (as on 15.03.2023) is given at **Annexure-I**.

(b) to (d): As per the information shared by the State Government of Rajasthan, district-wise pending liabilities of skilled & semi-skilled workers' wages under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS as on 18.03.2023 is given at **Annexure-II**.

The wage payment of skilled & semi-skilled workers is a continuous process. Some reasons for pending liability for skilled and semi-skilled workers are (i) bank account number not verified by Public Financial Management System (PFMS), rejection of payment due to closure of accounts etc.

The steps being taken to ensure timely payment wages to skilled and semi-skilled workers are: (i) verification of bank accounts on PFMS and (ii) for rejected payment cases, camps are organized at gram panchayat level and new accounts are opened and payment is being processed.
