FAMILIES COVERED UNDER DAY-NRLM

3428. SHRIMATI DELKAR KALABEN MOHANBHAI:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of families which have been covered under the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM) during each of the last two years, State/UT-wise including Dadra Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu;
- (b) whether there are still many such families in different rural areas of the country who have been deprived from the benefits of this mission;
- (c) if so, the measures taken/plans made by the Government in this regard so that deprived families can avail the benefits; and
- (d) the details of action taken by the Government in this regard so far, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

- (a) The State/UT-wise details of the rural households mobilised into Self Help Groups (SHGs) under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) during the last two year, including in Dadra Nagar Haveli, Daman and Diu, is given at Annexure I.
- (b) DAY-NRLM aims to bring under the SHG network about 10 crore women from rural poor households by Financial Year (FY) 2023-24. The Mission has already mobilized approximately 8.93 crore women from rural households into 82.61 Lakh SHGs as on 28th February 2023.
- (c) & (d) A social mobilization campaign was organised from 7th September to 30th September, 2022 in order to expedite the process of social mobilization for bringing women from left out eligible rural poor households into Self Help Groups (SHGs) under the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM). During this campaign 16,25,286 rural households were mobilized into 1,29,493 SHGs. State-wise details of achievement in this social mobilization campaign is placed at Annexure-II.
