# LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 3444 TO BE ANSWERED ON 21.03.2023

## **National Young Leaders Programme**

### 3444. SHRIMATI SANGEETA AZAD:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is implementing National Young Leaders Programme (NYLP) in the country and if so, the details thereof along with aims, objectives and various components of the said programme;
- (b) the details of funds allocated/released and expenditure incurred under the said programme since its inception, State/UT-wise including Uttar Pradesh;
- (c) the number of programmes organized under NYLP since its inception in Uttar Pradesh; and
- (d) the details of various activities undertaken and the number of youth actively participated/involved in governance process under NYLP, particularly Uttar Pradesh?

#### **ANSWER**

# THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS & SPORTS (SHRI ANURAG SINGH THAKUR)

(a) Yes, the Government is implementing National Young Leaders Programme (NYLP) since December, 2014 with the objective to develop leadership qualities among the youth to enable them to realise their full potential and in the process, to contribute to the nation-building process. NYLP is one of the sub-schemes under the Rashtriya Yuva Shashaktikaran Karyakram, a Central Sector

Scheme of the Ministry. The Programme aims at motivating the youth to strive for excellence in their respective fields and to bring them to the forefront of the development process. It seeks to harness the immense youth energy for national-building. At present, various components of NYLP include Neighbourhood Youth Parliament (NYP), Youth for Development Programme (YFDP) and National Youth Advisory Council (NYAC).

- (b) Under the Neighbourhood Youth Parliament component of the NYLP, funds are released to NYKS Headquarter for further release to its District level offices for conduct of programs all over the country. Details of funds allocated to NYKS and expenditure incurred from 2014-15 to 2022-23 State/UT-wise is placed at Annexure-1.
- (c) & (d) The number of programmes organized and the number of youth actively participated/involved under NYLP since its inception in Uttar Pradesh is placed at Annexure-2.
- (1) Under the Youth for Development Programme (YFDP), youth are involved in Shramdaan (voluntary labour) which helps them to develop their personality and leadership qualities and promote the spirit of 'dignity of labour' and channelizes the immense youth energy towards nation building. For instance, Cleanliness activities are a special area of focus as far as activities under this Programme are concerned. Department of Youth Affairs had taken up Clean India campaign on the model of 'Jan Bhagidari to Jan Andolan' with the target of collecting and disposing of waste, mainly Single Use Plastic in the span of one month from 01st to 31st October. In the last 2 years, total of 114 Lakh kgs and 156 Lakh kgs of plastic waste were collected and disposed.
- (2) Under NYLP, an institutional platform have been created in the form of Neighbourhood Youth Parliaments (NYP), where the youth in the age group of 15-29 years articulate their views on various issues affecting their lives and draw attention of the local administration. Neighbourhood Youth Parliaments provide a platform to educate youth about contemporary socio-economic development issues

confronting local communities in general and the youths in particular like literacy, consumer awareness, community health, cleanliness, child marriage, environment conservation, women empowerment, skill development etc.

During the current year (2022-23), the year of India's prestigious G20 presidency, the NYKS is conducting 763 Neighbourhood Youth Parliament programmes dovetailing the G-20 theme of "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam" or "One Earth, One Family, One Future" across the country.

The sessions of District Youth Parliament are organized keeping in mind the 5 Themes of Y20 namely (i) Future of Work: Industry 4.0, Innovation & 21st Century skills, (ii) Climate Change and Disaster Risk Reduction: Making Sustainability a way of life (iii) Peace building and Reconciliation: Ushering in an era of No War (iv) Shared Future: Youth in Democracy and Governance and (v) Health, Wellbeing & Sports: Agenda for Youth.
